




HISTORY COMES TO LIFE

Step back in time and engage yourself in Sweden's 19th century heritage. Wander through streets lined with houses and buildings of vast cultural and historical significance. Have a look inside the humble worker's residence, where families once shared a single room and kitchen, offering a glimpse into daily life of the era. Each location offers a unique window into Sweden's rich past, providing visitors with a truly unforgettable journey through time.

Torekällberget has no admission fee's, except for special events and guided tours for groups.





Visitors can experience Christmas as it was celebrated in the 1800s, as well as traditional Swedish celebrations such as National Day and Midsummer, among other events throughout the year.

Many of the houses at Torekällberget are authentically furnished with artifacts from the museum's vast collections, offering a portrayal of life during the latter half of the 19th century and early 20th century. Stroll through the 19th century promenade park complete with twisting pathways, a soothing pond, and a charming pavilion. Additionally, the town square features several smaller exhibitions showing the rich history of Södertälje, providing visitors with fascinating insights into the area's past.

TOREKÄLLBERGET OPEN-AIR MUSEUM

Just beyond the historic town lies an old-fashioned farmhouse and soldier's cottage, nestled amidst lush paddocks and lush landscapes. Here, visitors can encounter our collection of historic domestic animal breeds, including sheep, cows, horses, goats, rabbits, and chickens.

Guided tours of the animals are available on weekends and school holidays, providing an educational and immersive experience for visitors of all ages.







Board a truly unique journey, as you step back in time and experience the magic of a bygone era. This extraordinary vessel holds the distinction of being the world's oldest coalfired, propeller-powered steamship, still powered by its original motor dating back more than a hundred years.

The steamship is not just a charming relic; it is a floating museum that offers a unique opportunity to engage yourself in history.

Ejdern was built in 1880 at the Gothenburg Mechanical Workshop to operate in coastal traffic in the Gothenburg archipelago and was launched on May 14 of the same year. Between the years 1898 and 1906, Ejdern navigated the waters around Östergötland before eventually ending up in Södertälje.



During the summer season, S/S Ejdern becomes your gateway to some of Sweden's most captivating destinations. Hop aboard and cruise for Stockholm, the vibrant capital city. Or hit course for the fairytale-like town of Mariefred or the old Viking city of Birka, a UNESCO World Heritage site.

It is also possible to charter the ship for maximum 90 passengers.






