


THE BEAUTY OF THE WILD

Within a short distance, visitors can embark on diverse excursions, from coastal explorations to forest hikes, leisurely strolls along marked trails, ascents of hills and valleys, serene paddles in clear waters, and idyllic walks past fields and farms. Nature enthusiasts can also marvel at rare flowers and plants, adding an element of discovery to their outdoor adventures.





The old Swedish custom *Allemansrätten*, or Right of Public Access, means you can move freely in Swedish nature. It allows everyone the access public and private land for activities like hiking and camping. It reflects Sweden's commitment to conservation and emphasizes the responsibility of visitors to care for and protect the environment while enjoying its beauty. Map of Swedish nature (Södertälje)






In collaboration with Björcks resor bus transfer from Arlanda International Airport or Stockholm Central is avabiable. Group bookings can be made for any day and time between May and October.
